



## Autumn Term Year 1 Curriculum

### Hello and welcome!

We hope you have all had a lovely summer break; it is lovely to have the children back and telling us all their summer news. We can see that the children have all settled in well and cracking on with their learning in class.

### The Year 1 Curriculum

**Science** – Animals, including humans: identify body parts and associate with one of the 5 senses; identify, name and sort into classes a variety of common animals; know what animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

**Geography** – Local Study: fieldwork and observational skills to identify key human and physical features around the school and local area.

**History** – Toys: changes in living memory. Sequencing events in chronological order; observe similarities and differences in artefacts.

**Computing** – Esafety: to use technology safely and respectfully; identify where to go for help and support; use keyboard and mouse effectively and save information. Use of technology in the wider world.

**DT & Art** – Drawing: Experiment with a variety of media; pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, pen and chalk.

### Literacy

- Consistently use Key Words/High frequency words in reading and writing.
- Letter formation – using lead in and exit strokes.
- Group and individual reading at own levels.
- Phonics and Spelling + Tricky Words
- Sequence and pick out the key ideas.
- Describe stories according to setting.
- Learning and embedding grammatical vocabulary: adjective, none, personal pronoun, verb
- Writing in a range of genres.
- Performance poetry.
- Feedback and editing completed work.

### Numeracy

- Count, read and write numbers 0-10
- Count one more and one less
- Compare groups using language – equal more, greater, less, fewer.
- Use symbols = > and <
- Order and compare numbers and groups of numbers, using language – greatest, smallest.
- Ordinal numbers (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>...)
- Number line work with addition and subtraction
- Number bonds to 10 [Weekly speed test]
