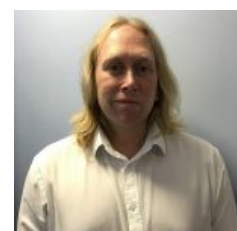
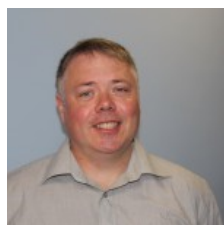




Meet the Governors
