## Welcome Back!

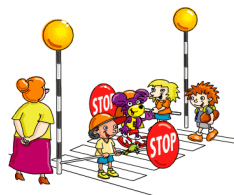

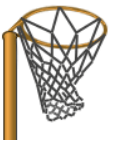
## Mobile Phones
