The amount of lost property is at an all time high, with lots of shoes as well as clothes. Please come and have a look through, otherwise any remaining items will be sent to charity.



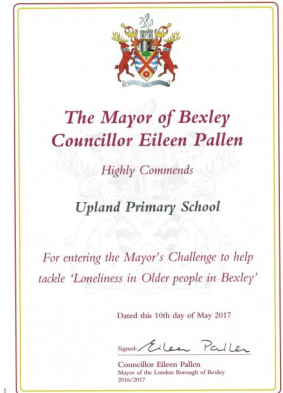

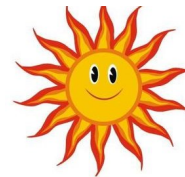
## Loneliness in Bexley
