Tailgating

Free School Eligibility

Has there been a change in your family financial circumstances? If so your child may be eligible for free school meals. If you are unsure please do contact the school office.

If your child does not have Free School Meals, but may be eligible because of your family's income level, please contact the school office (in confidence) to register them. Even if you do not wish them to have the meals, this would mean the school could still claim Pupil Premium Funding that will be used to help your child in school.

Attendance

Attendance figures for Autumn term were very impressive.

As a school the overall attendance was 97.1% our target is over 96 % each term so this is really good.

Congratulations to Bramble Class 98% and Mars class 99% who were the termly class attendance winners.

136 children received the 100% termly attendance certificate. Thank you for getting your children to school regularly.
