## School closure for election



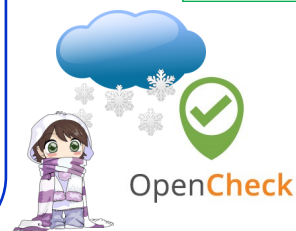
On Thursday 12th December the school will be closed as the site is used as a polling station for the general election. NO children are to attend school on this day. We will be open again as usual on Friday 13th December.
